Don't forget to plan your design in your homework book first!	Design/ draw your own invertebrate creature and its habitat.
Partner Filming Fun With a friend(s), create a short film documentary where you visit your local woodland. Show and discuss the possible food chains that exist there.	Write a poem (free verse or rhyme) about your favourite thing that you have learned about this term.	Design a crossword using keywords from our topics this term. For example, you could use words linked to our geography or science topics.	Create a quiz about Antarctica. Try to include at least 5 questions that you can challenge your friends with!
